EVENTS

In addition to attending annual meeting, the Young Professionals Board will organize a minimum of 2 fundraising events annually. *YPB members are expected to attend all events, assist in the sale of tickets and serve on the planning committee of at least 1 event per year.*

Duration

YPB members serve a one-year term. At the end of the term, YPB members have the opportunity to re-join (with approval of the board) or find an acceptable replacement.
